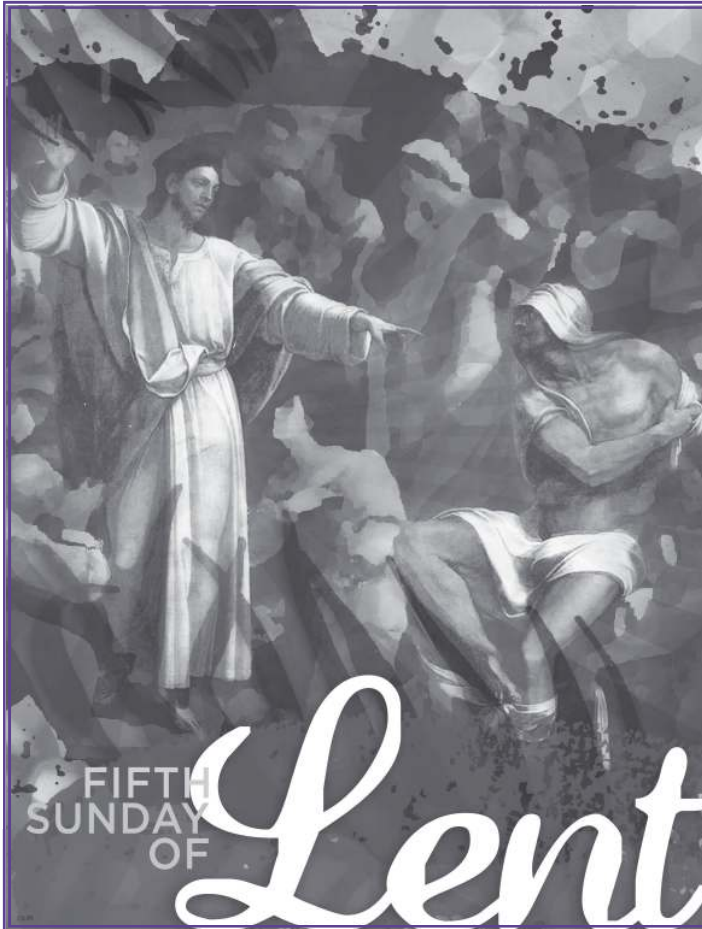

Annual Jericho Walk for Life on Good Friday, April 14.

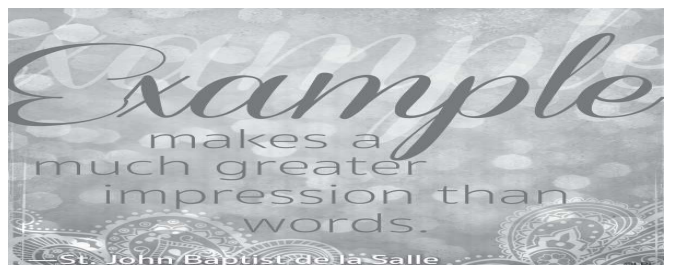
